INTERVIEW GUIDE



TIME NEEDED: Up to 60 min

The interviews conducted with seniors from your community will act as the foundation for the comics you create (answers to Q5 in particular). Below is a list of questions you can ask to help draw out their story. Feel free to put these questions into your own words and to ask follow up questions that may not be included here.

Don't forget to introduce yourself before jumping in to the interview.

1. Can you tell me a little bit about yourself?

- a. Where is your family from originally?
- b. What caused or encouraged your family to come to Canada?

2. What part of the province have you spent the most time living in?

3. Do you feel a strong sense of belonging to the province of Quebec?

- a. Why or why not?

* Belonging: To be accepted, wanted, needed, seen, to fit in, to experience a sense of connection to a place or group of people.

4. What do you think allows people to feel a strong sense of belonging to a community?

5. Can you tell me about a time in your life when you helped to make a positive difference for your community?

- a. What did you say? What did you do?
- b. When was this?
 - i) What did the community look like at this period of time? How was it different from today?
 - ii) Would you be willing to show us a photo, newspaper clipping or other item you've kept from that period in time?
- c. What impact did your action(s) have?

6. What type of actions do you think are needed today to help people feel welcome in our community?
