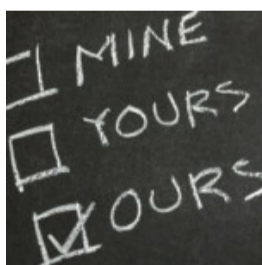
## The Daily 5 in Action: An Intensive ESL Teacher's Experience
