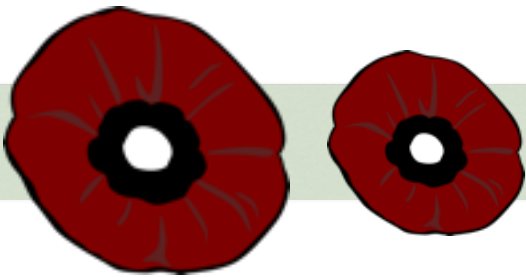
## Upcoming ESL Swap Shop
