<b>Level</b>	Elementary Cycle Three, Grade 6 Intensive ESL
<b>Meaningful/Authentic Task</b>	To individually create a Top-3 list of the most interesting superstitions to be published on the ESL class blog.
<b>Purpose</b>	To inform
<b>Audience</b>	Peers
<b>Evaluation Criterion</b>	<i>Use of knowledge from texts in a reinvestment task</i>
<b>Task Requirements:</b> select, organize and personalize knowledge (i.e. information/ideas, language) from texts provided in light of purpose and audience	<p><b>Select:</b> Choose three superstitions as well as relevant knowledge (e.g. <i>origin, description, consequence</i>) from three of the texts provided.</p> <p><b>Organize:</b> Use this knowledge to plan an outline of the final product.</p> <p><b>Personalize:</b> In the outline, combine knowledge from texts with own ideas to explain why the three superstitions are interesting choices (e.g. <i>It is interesting because . . . , It surprised me because . . . , I think it's strange because . . . , I chose this superstition because . . . , I agree with this superstition because . . .</i> ).</p>
